

YOU CAN ASK THAT BY WHITE RIBBON AUSTRALIA

You Can Ask That is a panel discussion that provides knowledge, tools and strategies to foster respectful relationships, promote gender equality and prevent harassment and abuse.



It aims to:

- Undermine attitudes, gender stereotypes and disrespect that are drivers of violence and abuse.
- Help young people understand what they can do.
- Strengthen the change that is needed through a primary prevention approach.
- Broaden understanding of sexism and advance gender equality.

You Can Ask That is a 60 minute panel-style conversation for people to learn about the issue of domestic violence and how to prevent it.

Part 1

A panel of primary prevention experts hosted by White Ribbon Australia will lead a fire-side conversation answering four topics relating to the drivers of violence, abuse and disrespect.

Part 2

This part of the conversation will enable our audience to submit questions to the panelists that they will answer. Questions that you Google are on the table.

Part 3

Optional tailored primary prevention program for our audience to participate in after the panel.

Outcomes

- To learn about the drivers of violence, abuse and disrespect towards women.
- To learn practical solutions and new responses to address comments or behaviours of disrespect that you might witness with your mates.
- To learn about how you can be a champion of change and address violence, abuse and disrespect.
